LECTURE ON

The session was on robotics along with a demonstration of robot. Prior to the session, there was an industrial visit for the speaker and participants to understand the use of automation and robots by Shriram Pistons and Rings ltd. There were two lines in Piston foundry shop with full of robots, pouring molten metal of Aluminium in dies and pick & place of casted piston. In Piston machine shop, in one lines eight machines were connected by robots where total piston machining was done by robots.

The automation was also explained in quality checking of Pistons and Rings. The session was taken by Mr. Satish AV of orangewood Research & Development Pvt Ltd. 26 participants attended the session including industry visit.
