Webinar on "HOW TO SAFEGUARD YOUR INVESTMENT"

ACTIVITY #1

was organized on 13th January 2022. In this session, the distinguished speaker was CA Devendra Arora, CEO, Tejas Investments.

Mr. Arora explained that Stock markets, these days, are in bull phase and the experts are generally showing optimism, but Investors at large have many apprehensions about current levels of stock markets and are fearful that market may tank as it happened in March 2020. The bounce back has been too fast and too much, while the fundamentals of the country's economy have a lot of catching up to do. Only few industries have done well but largely the economy has still to recover the lost grounds. The current market conditions have left investors confused as to how to safeguard their hard-earned money; whether to redeem their investments and realize profits, invest more or do something else. In this session I shall share my strategy to sail through current situation.


